OVERVIEW

To effectively lead others, one must first understand and be able to lead, one's self.

This workshop will help participants cultivate a deeper level of self-knowledge and knowledge; including an understanding of their core values, beliefs, and purpose.

We will also address some of the key challenges and strategies to help rising leaders manage both their time and energy, more effectively.

Specifically, participants will learn to:

- Build Self-Awareness / Emotional Intelligence: Like great companies, great leaders are values-driven. We will work through an energizing and enlightening values discovery exercise that will help leaders better understand the values and principles guiding their decision-making.
- Create A Clear + Compelling Personal Strategy: Every leader must be able to answer three critical questions: 1) Where am I, professionally? 2) Where do I want to go? 3) How am I going to get there? During this discussion we will learn a smart, intuitive framework for setting, and executing against personal and professional goals.
- Execute Like A Pro: We all have more to do then time to do it. During this module we will learn the art of getting things done. Specifically, leaders will discover how to both identify, and execute against, top priorities so that you have the time and energy to get your most important work done well.
