

The mission of South Carolina Business Week is to contribute to the preparation of young adults for the business environment by introducing them to the principles of leadership, teamwork and the American free enterprise system while promoting self-reliance, individual responsibility and entrepreneurship.

What is South Carolina Business Week?

- An inside look at business in action, this program is designed to educate high school students on entrepreneurship and the American free enterprise system.
- Students attend the program fully sponsored on scholarships from the business community – only a \$50 fee is due upon acceptance.
- Held on the campus of Presbyterian College in Clinton, South Carolina July 10-15, 2011.

Who Makes Up the Faculty?

- 30-40 leaders in business, education and government share their special knowledge and skills with the students.
- CEOs from some of South Carolina's largest corporations provide the big picture.
- Students will hear from experts in economics, diversity, communications, international business, management and research and development.

Who Can Participate?

STUDENTS MUST:

- Have completed their sophomore, junior or senior year during the spring of 2011;
- Be currently ranked in the top one-third of their class; and
- Possess demonstrated leadership skills through school and community activities.

Is There Time for Fun?

- Students will be permitted to use the recreational facilities at the college every day.
- Planned activities, such as a pizza party, a dance, a movie and a talent show, will allow time to meet new friends from across South Carolina.

How Does the Program Work?

- Students form mock companies of 10-12 students.
- Student companies are led by Company Advisors, loaned executives from companies across South Carolina.
- Students attend workshops on all aspects of business and test newly-acquired knowledge in a computer business simulation game.
- Students will compete in challenges to make their company the most profitable through sound business decisions.



What is Covered by the Business Scholarships?

- The cost of living in a dorm room at Presbyterian College
- Three meals a day
- All instructional materials

How Do I Apply?

TO BE ACCEPTED INTO THE PROGRAM, STUDENTS MUST:

- Rank academically in the top one-third of their class;
- Have completed their sophomore, junior or senior year by the end of spring 2011;
- Possess demonstrated leadership skills through school and community activities;
- Complete the enclosed application form in its entirety with the signatures of school principal or guidance counselor, and return to the S.C. Chamber.
- Upon receipt of applications, students will receive a notification of acceptance within three weeks. Do not include the \$50 registration fee with the application. Students will be mailed an acceptance letter detailing when to send the \$50 registration fee.
- Students are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis with class rank and application content taken into consideration.
- Essay: Write a brief (i.e., minimum 250 words, maximum 500 words) explanation about what you hope to gain by attending Business Week and how you think this experience will provide a background for your future in the working world. Please type, if possible, or use a pen and write legibly. Please staple to application. Students, including returning students, must submit an original essay. Essays from previous years will not be accepted.

Deadline:

The deadline for receipt of applications is April 15, 2011. Applications received after April 15 will be accepted based on availability. Returning students will be accepted after April 15 if space permits.
