****POTENTIAL OSHA CHANGES****

The United Nations adopted the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labeling of Chemicals (GHS), and now OSHA is looking at implementing it into their Hazard Communication Standard. The status of this requirement will be reviewed based on OSHA's time table. This will be a major change to HAZ COM with reference to Programs, Labeling, Training and Material Safety Data Sheets. If changes are made before the class, the instructor will provide an overview of the new requirements. In addition, the instructor will review proposed OSHA record keeping regulation changes.

CERTIFICATION

Upon completion of the course, participants will receive a federal OSHA 10-hour or 30-hour card. This card demonstrates your company's efforts toward voluntary compliance with OSHA standards and will be useful during an inspection.

This will be the only 10/30 - Hour OSHA training offered by the Chamber in 2014.
